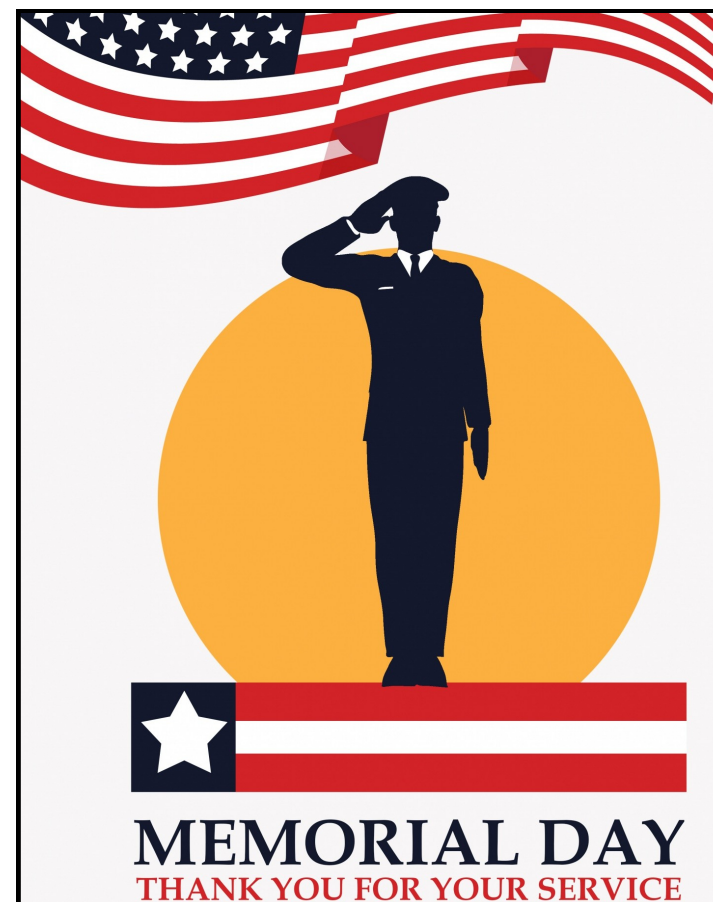

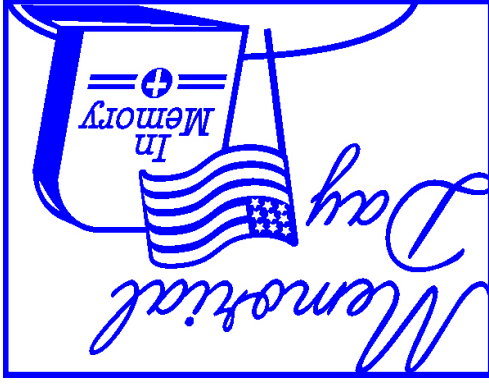
The Prelude

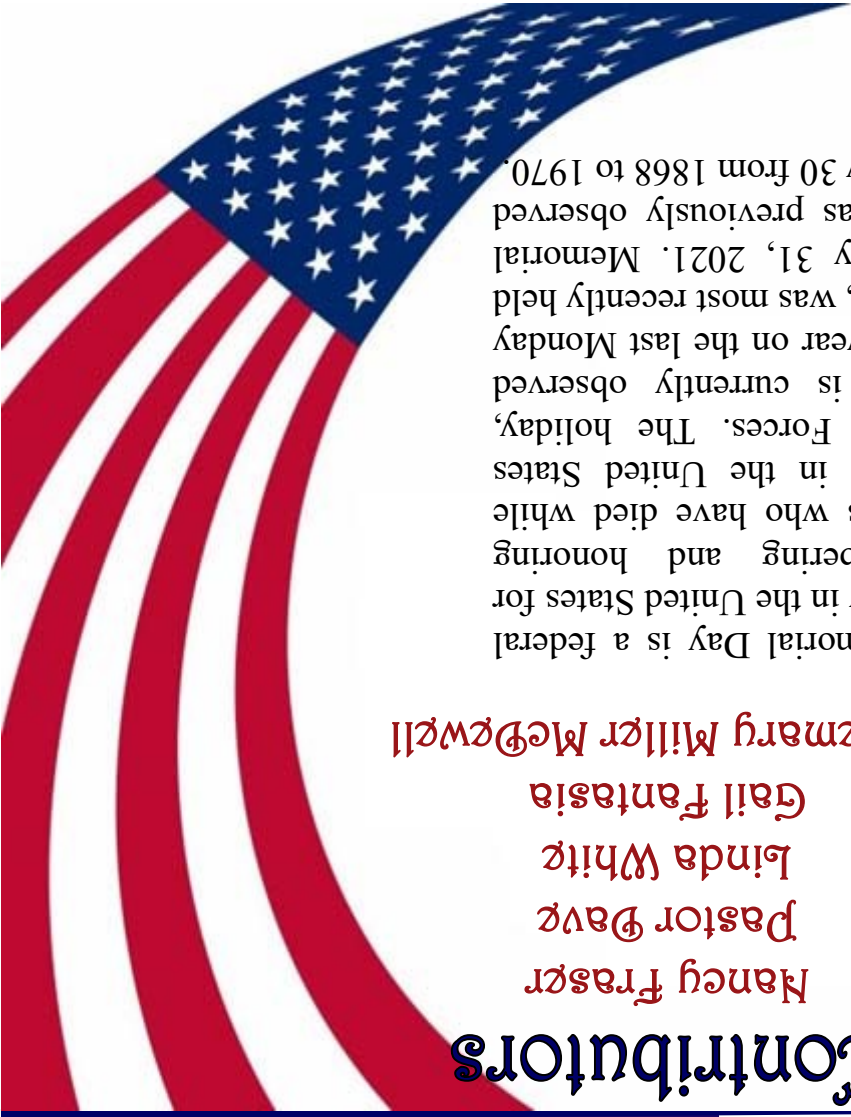
